



The outstanding win of Written Tycoon 3 year old Gunn Island on debut at Cranbourne today confirmed the opinion the Hayes stable have of the progeny of the Woodside Park Stallion.

Having enjoyed good success earlier in the season with 2yo Blue Tycoon, the stable were excited about the prospects of a couple of unraced horses purchased by Bloodstock Agent Mark Pilkington. Wall Street Wolf was the first to race having been purchased by Pilkington following a very impressive Trial win at Geelong. Heavily supported at Flemington in his initial race appearance, he ran an unlucky 3<sup>rd</sup> but showed his true potential winning his next start at Geelong by 8 lengths as an unbackable favourite

As promising as Wall Street Wolf is, he may be upstaged by today's debutante Gunn Island. Purchased at the New Zealand Ready To Run Sale by Pilkington for \$NZ130,000. His stunning debut win has connections heading to the Group 1 Caulfield Guineas with more than an outside chance.

Written Tycoons start to the new season has been highlighted by the Missile Stakes victory of Tycoon Tara and the eagerly awaited return of Golden Slipper Winner Capitalist in Saturdays Group 3 San Domenico Stakes.
